


Q RAMKRISHNA MISSION


The steaming hot Khichadi was distributed among 60 Sadhus and 70 students at the ashram plus 150 slum dwellers and rickshaw pullers.








CHANDA SATSANG VIDYALAYA, LATHIRA

A special lunch followed by the distribution of delicious Diwali sweets was organized by the Delhi SSM members.












The home is run for destitute girl children and for families who can't afford education, food, and shelter.

Lunch, dinner, and special sweets for all 110 inhabitants was served.




SSM Kerala team celebrated by offering Annadhanam & serving breakfast for Anandatheeram inmates, a home for differently-abled children.


Team SSM Bangalore visited St John Hospital & distributed 200 Puliyogare meal boxes to the caretakers of poor patients.



Children received a goody bag filled with stationery, chocolates & biscuits which brought a huge smile on their faces!



Lunch comprised of vegetable biryani, potato curry, raita, savories, sweet bananas, and laddoos.


